What

On Thursday, April 21, the Museum of Fine Arts, Houston, presents a lecture and dance performance, *Swingin' at the Savoy: Dance from the Big Band Era*, presented by choreographer Andrea Cody, founding director of Dance Houston. The lecture and performance is inspired by the Jazz Age vehicles and works of art in the exhibitions *Sculpted in Steel: Art Deco Automobiles and Motorcycles, 1929–1940* and *Deco Nights: Evenings in the Jazz Age*. Joining Cody on stage are members of the Houston Hepcats and Swing Rhapsody.
